NDC is collaborating with the City of Greenbelt and representatives from the Greenbelt Station community to generate a plan that creates welcoming and safe spaces that foster creativity and community connections and support a healthy, inclusive, thriving neighborhood.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS FINAL BUDGET REVIEW MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

While meeting minutes are approved at the subsequent meeting, we want to provide relevant updates to keep the community informed.

Here is a summary of the key points discussed during the Board meeting held last Thursday:

The Board of Directors has approved the distribution of the 2024 Draft Budget for a membership comment period. The adoption is scheduled for November 16, 2023.

The ordering of coupons in advance of the November meeting was approved.

<u>Safety Assessment Walkthrough:</u> Members of the Board of Directors conducted a Safety Assessment walkthrough with City of Greenbelt council members and City of Greenbelt Police Chief Bower. Recommendations were made, and they will be discussed further at the January 2024 Board meeting. Input from the Ad-Hoc Neighborhood Watch Committee is needed.

The Ad-Hoc Neighborhood Watch Committee is in need of volunteers. The Committee will investigate possible deterrents to mitigate crime opportunities. This short-term Committee will meet virtually 2-3 times or as needed. The Greenbelt Station Master Association Board wants to hear from the community! Join and share your thoughts and feedback.
